Basketball Buddy Night

The kids will have an opportunity to participate in a basketball Buddy Night at a Varsity Basketball Game. We will assign kids to different Buddy Nights after registration. On Buddy Nights the youth players would come to the JV game where they would play a short game at half time of the JV game, get introduced at the Varsity Game, sit on the bench at the varsity game and then play a short game at half time of the Varsity game. A schedule of Buddy Nights will be sent out at a later date.

Fee

Bad Weather

If the weather is bad, we will follow the school storm procedure. If school gets out early there will be no practice after school. If the weather is questionable we might choose to cancel practice and we will make an announcement at school regarding the cancellation. If the weather is bad on Saturdays, we will get an announcement out using Instant Alert. All weather cancellations will be done through Instant Alert.
