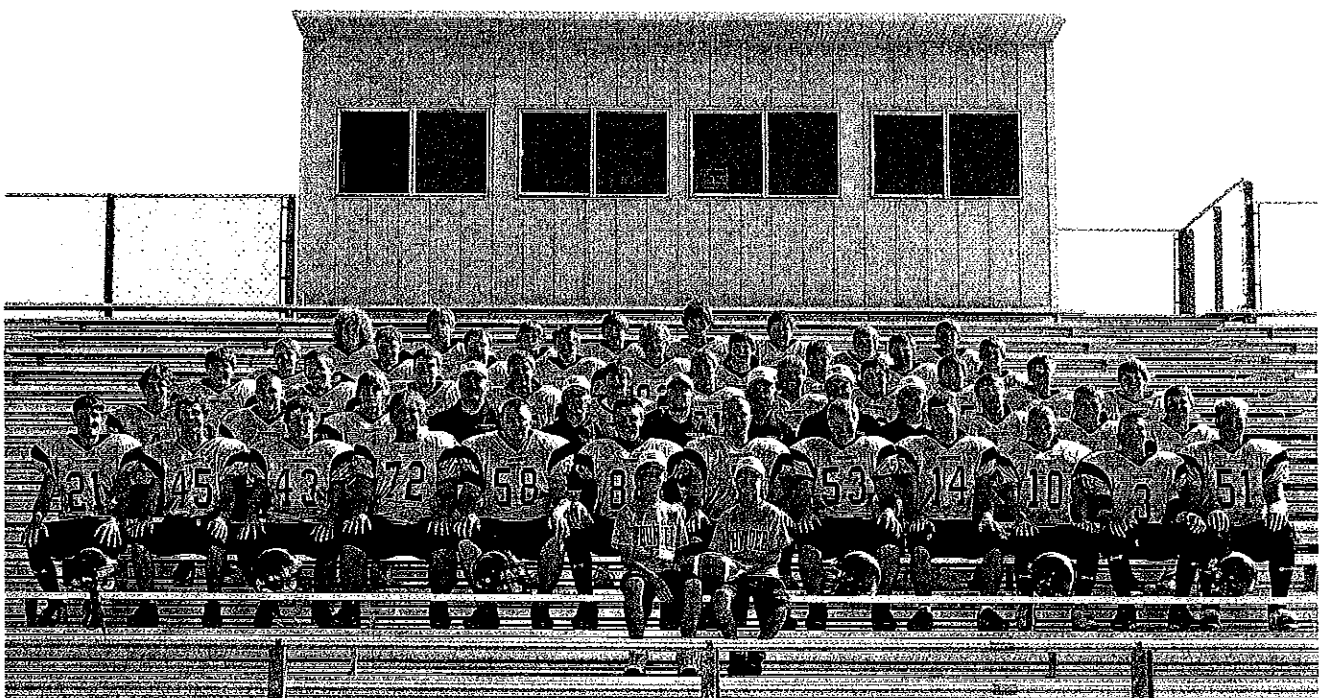

Coaching Additions Will Help Thunder

Bryan Strand begins his second year as head coach of the Agassiz Valley Thunder football team with an improved coaching staff which includes Hall-of-Fame coach **Andy McCarty** from Park Rapids, and **Al Holmes** who has had stints at Battle Lake High School, Mayville State University, Brainerd Community College, Moorhead State University and Michigan Tech.

"Those additions will help us improve as a team, and along with volunteer coaches **Mason Askegaard** and **Dana Brakke** we'll have more coaches able to spend more time teaching fundamentals," noted Coach Strand. "We'll be a faster team than last year. We won't have as much size, but with an improved speed factor we should be able to do more things."

Phil Trowbridge, **Matt Askegaard** and **Tracy Hintz** are the returning coaches on what will be a deep staf for Coach Strand.

All-Conference fullback/linebacker **Cody Cox** (JR) leads the group of returning starters, which includes seniors **Aaron Schindler** (RB/DE), **Kirk Anderson** (Wing/SS), **Brent Halverson** (E/DE), **Landon Peppel** (LB), **Brandon Fankhanel** (RB/DB), **Jared Nelson** (G/DT) and **Rusty Renecker** (T/DT), and juniors **Troy Longtin** (G/NG) and **Zach Olson** (QB).

"Most of our starters are back on a defense that ranked in the middle of the HOL last year," stated Strand. "With more ball control we should be able to be in more games and give ourselves a chance to be successful. We were a minus-21 on turnovers last year and hopefully that will improve. That was the number one factor that took us out of games."

Cox, Schindler, Anderson and Halverson will serve as team captains. Key varsity newcomers will be senior **John Emmerich** (WR/CB) and juniors **Anders Gylland** (RB/DB) and **Michael Brandt** (RB/DB).

The Thunder won their season opener, holding them to a negative eight yards rushing, but then lost their next eight games in the always tough Heart O' Lakes Conference.

"We came together as a team, worked hard the entire year, just didn't end up with the wins we wanted," Strand continued. "We made great strides in becoming a better football team during the season."

Strand points to Perham, DGF, Breckenridge and Pelican Rapids as teams to beat in the HOL, while Hawley, DGF and Pelican are his favorites in Section 8AA.

Thunder Dominate on Opening Night in Walker

The Agassiz Valley Thunder opened the season with Walker-Hackensack-Akeley and came out with a 42-13 win.

W-H-A went 81 yards on their first play from scrimmage, an 81 yard option, giving them a 7-0 lead.

"We had said they would run that play before the game," said Coach Bryan Strand. "A few missed tackles and we were down. We bounced right back going the length of the field in 3 plays."

Zach Olson hit **Landon Peppel** on a slant pass for 51 yards, and the Thunder converted the two point conversion, having **Aaron Schindler** run it in around the right side. The next possession Walker fumbled the ball on the kickoff and Agassiz Valley took the ball again and drove it down the field. **Cody Cox** got his numbered call for the first of his three touchdowns, and he also converted on the two point conversion.

"On the ensuing kickoff we had some issues with people coming off of specialty teams and not getting a replacement and we kicked off with 10 guys, and they ran right to where that one should have been and returned it 75 yards for the TD," noted Strand. "I will say that it must have been first game mistakes, we wont be doing that again."

Cox ran in another touchdown before the half and also ran in another 2 point conversion as the Thunder led 24-13 at the half.

Schindler broke a long run early in the third quarter going 30 yards right up the middle, and Zach Olson ran in the score. They failed on the two point conversion.

Later in the thrid quarter Zach Olson hit **John Emmerich** for a long pass, with Emmerich taking it it 35 yards to the 2 yard line before losing the ball on a fumble. Two plays later the Agassiz Valley defense came up strong and took the ball back right at the end of the quarter. Cody Cox plunged in the endzone 3 plays later and **Mandy Johnson** missed the extra point kick.

Michael Brandt finished our scoring by scampering 23 yards on a sweep and the PAT attempt failed because of a bad hold.

"We did lose Aaron Schindler in the third quarter to an AC separation in his shoulder, but we hope to get him back in a few weeks," added Coach Strand. He rushed for 163 yards on 16 carries and is one of our leaders."

Cody Cox rushed for 110 yards on 19 carries, 3 TD's and two 2 point conversions. He also had 6 solo tackles, and 8 assisted tackles. Zach Olson was 3 for 6 passing for 88 yards, threw one TD pass and ran for another touchdown. As a team the Thunder had 351 yards rushing on 57 attempts. Landon Peppel had 1 catch for 51 yards and a TD, John Emmerich had 1 catch for 35 yards.

"Defensively, after we gave up that one big play to start the game we settled down," said Strand. "Walker rushed for 140 yards on 26 attempts, and passed for 55 yards."

Strand continued, "Besides the injury to Schindler we came out pretty healthy and the kids were all smiles after the game. The kids are looking forward to moving to the new conference next year where we will get a chance to play teams like Walker that are our same size. The kids have worked hard and to see them have a night like this

is so rewarding. The coaches have also done an outstanding job, **Andy McCarty** has brought a new level to our offense as well as volunteer coach **Al Holmes**. **Phil Trowbridge** is my top assistant and he is always working at one aspect of the game or another, he does a great job. Our staff has doubled in size since last year and I believe you can tell in the way the kids played the game last night. We only put the ball on the ground a couple of times and we only lost the ball once. In a downpour like that, I would say we took good care of the ball."

The West Central Area Knights will invade Barensville for a seven o'clock game on Friday night.

"They are good," observed Strand. "I saw them absolutely destroy Mahanomen. They are well coached and should be a great test for us. They are small but very quick and **Kolton Lee** is one of the best passers I have seen, and he is only a junior. I hope it rains next Friday like it did last night."

Giese Catches 3 TD Passes as Knights Beat Thunder 44-18

Andrew Giese hauled in five passes for 143 yards and scored three touchdowns on Friday night as the West Central Area Knights defeated the Agassiz Valley Thunder by a score of 44-18 in Barnesville.

The Knights took charge of the game early as they jumped out to leads of 20-0 after one quarter and 38-0 at half time. Each team scored six points in the third quarter and Agassiz Valley closed out the game with 12 fourth quarter points. WCA used their starters in the first half, but went to their bench midway through the third quarter, giving many underclassmen an opportunity to see some extended varsity playing time.

Kolten Lee got the scoring started on an eight yard run and then connected with Giese on an 11-yard pass in the first quarter, making it a 12-0 game. **Mitch Ronhovde** broke a sixty yard run for the third West Central Area score and **Dayton Sternhagen** was on the receiving end of a two-point conversion pass from Lee for the final score of the opening quarter.

In the second quarter, **Jaime Magnuson** caught a 17-yard pass from Lee, Giese made a 30-yard TD reception and Ronhovde went over from a yard out.

The Knights went up 44-0 when Lee hit Giese with an 88-yard touchdown pass to start the third quarter.

An 80-yard kick-off return by Jon Emmerich got the Thunder on the scoreboard to put the score at 44-6 after three quarters.

Agassiz Valley added two more scores, a 2-yard run by **Landon Peppel** and a two-yard run by **Devin Brakke**, in the final quarter of play.

Lee completed 12-of-19 passes for 258 yards and four touchdowns, while Ronhovde ran for 116 yards on 14 carries. West Central Area had 200 rushing yards and 269 yards passing for a total of 469 yards.

Agassiz Valley finished with 175 yards on the ground and 50 passing yards for a total of 225 yards.

Defensive leaders for the Knights were **Jace Loeks** with 10 tackles and one sack, **Tyler Larson** with 7 tackles and **Marshall Strand** with 5 tackles. Magnuson had an interception and Giese a fumble recovery for WCA. The Knights held the Thunder to no first downs in the first half.

West Central Area will host Roseau on Friday night in their first home game of the year.

Vikings Beat Thunder as Lightning Ends it Early

The Thunder and the lightning were both present in Pelican Rapids on Friday night. The Vikings silenced the Agassiz Valley Thunder on the football field by a score of 28-0, as the lightning forced an end to the game after the first half of play.

"I've never been involved in a game that was ended early," said Pelican Rapids Head Coach **David Haugen**. "It's really a strange feeling to all of a sudden have the game over. The players were disappointed but all understood the situation with dangerous weather in the area."

The Vikings scored less than four minutes into the game when **Chris Lage** took an option pitch and went in from 13 yards out to put them ahead 6-0. With 3:27 left in the opening quarter, **Zach Lundquist** went 34 yards for another TD and **Tydan Storrusten** hit **Andrew Skow-Anderson** with the two-point conversion pass, giving the Vikings a 14-0 lead after one quarter. The touchdown capped an 8 play drive which covered 57 yards.

"On our first possession we had a well executed screen pass between Storrusten and Skow-Anderson on fourth down to keep the drive alive, and on the second TD run, **Casey Klovstad** had a key block to spring Lundquist," recalled Haugen.

The Vikings third TD was an eight yard run by Andrew Sorum, scoring his first varsity touchdown. The scoring drive covered 63 yards, while using nine plays.

The final touchdown of the game was a ten yard pass completion from Storrusten to **Codi Guck**, who scored his first varsity TD.

"Defensively, we played very well," noted Coach Haugen. "Our pass coverage was better than the week before and our run defense was solid. Our interior line did a good job of getting penetration and taking on blockers. The penetration was a key to our success. Offensively, our line also took control of the line of scrimmage as we really were able to run the ball as the game went on."

Lundquist led all rushers with 161 yards on 17 carries, while the team finished with 195 yards rushing and 29 passing for 219 total yards.

Agassiz Valley got all of their yards on the ground, as Pelican Rapids held them to 31 yards. **Kirk Anderson** led the Thunder with 17 yards on 8 carries.

"We went into the game without three of four captains," reported Agassiz Valley Head Coach **Bryan Strand**. "All Conference linebacker Cody Cox missed the game with a high ankle sprain, senior running back Aaron Schindler, who rushed for 160 yards in week one as an AC separation of the shoulder, and senior end Brent Halverson broke his wrist in practice on Tuesday and is expected to be out four to six weeks. Add that to the fact that we lost our starting quarterback in the second quarter and both starting corners were hurt during the game, and it was a pretty rough night for us."

Landon Peppel led the defensive effort for Agassiz Valley with 3 solo tackles and 7 assisted tackles from his linebacker spot.

"I feel the kids we put on the field did an excellent job," Strand commented. "They are a good team and well

coached. We are going to have to find some kids to step up and make some plays."

Pelican Rapids will travel to Barrett on Friday night to play the unbeaten West Central Area Knights.

"They will be a big challenge for us," admitted Haugen. "WCA throws the ball well and has some very good athletes."

Agassiz Valley is now 1-2 and will host Roseau at seven o'clock Friday night in Barnesville.

Thunder Snap Conference Losing Streak at 18

The Agassiz Valley Thunder hadn't won a Heart O' Lakes Conference football game since the 2003 season, a stretch of eighteen straight games. That losing streak came to an end on Friday night when the Thunder beat the Frazee Hornets 14-6.

The Thunder scored again with about three minutes to go in the fourth quarter on a seven yard run by Schindler. Agassiz Valley squibbed the kickoff and recovered the ball, which enable them to run out the clock.

"We finally put together a complete game and if you take away our four fumbles, we really did play well," added Strand.

Defensively, Cox had two solo tackles along with 12 assisted tackles and a quarterback sack. **Kirk Anderson** had two solo tackles along with seven assisted tackles. **Casey Johnson** recorded 8 assisted tackles and a quarterback sack.

"It was great to see the kids and fans get behind the boys," concluded Coach Strand. "It truly was a wonderful win for this program."

Vikings Win Playoff Opener Against Thunder

The Pelican Rapids Vikings opened up the play-offs with a hard fought win over the Agassiz Valley Thunder on Tuesday night. The Vikings got on the scoreboard first with a scoring drive on their second possession of the game. Both teams started with 3 plays and a punt. The scoring drive used 16 plays and covered 90 yards. Pelican was successful on 3 third down conversions to keep the drive alive before **Zach Lundquist** scored on a 5 yard run. The **Porfirio Diaz** kick gave the home team a 7-0 lead.

The teams traded possessions again before the next Viking score. **Chris Lage** pinned the Thunder inside their own five yard line when his punt was downed. Forcing Agassiz Valley to punt from their endzone **Casey Klovstad** was able to chase down the punter in the endzone giving the Vikings 2 points on the safety.

It looked as if the Vikings might take control of the game early, but a turnover on the possession after the safety gave AV new life. **Brandon Fankhanel** intercepted a pass and returned it 34 yards for a touchdown. The two point conversion brought the Thunder within 1 point late in the first half.

Pelican Rapids responded with a touchdown on their next possession just as time expired at the end of the first half. **Tydan Storrusten** ran in from 12 yards out, just getting into the endzone before the defense could get to him. The extra point was blocked.

The third quarter and into the fourth Pelican Rapids was able to gain control of the game. Including the touchdown at the end of the first half the Vikings scored 27 unanswered points.

The third quarter began with the Viking defense forcing Agassiz Valley into 3 plays and a punt. The drive consisted of 6 plays covering 37 yards finished when **McKale Evenson** scored on an 8 yard run. Porfirio Diaz's kick was good again.

Chris Lage scored on a 17 yard run and the Diaz kick put the Vikings up 29 - 8. This drive covered 55 yards and used only 6 plays.

Pelican Rapids finished out their scoring on their next possessions. This drive used 10 plays to cover 70 yards and used nearly 4 and a half minutes making it difficult for AV to mount a comeback. The final score came on a 19 yard run by Tydan Storrusten. With the kick by Porfirio Diaz the Vikings were up 36 - 8.

Agassiz Valley kept playing hard and came up with two more touchdowns on the night.

The first came on a 25 yard run by **Aaron Schindler**. The extra point kick failed. After a successful on-side kick AV gained possession at the Pelican Rapids 46 yard line. On the 10th play of the drive the Thunder connected on an 18 yard pass from **Zach Olson** to **Kirk Anderson** as time expired. With no time on the clock the extra point kick was missed leaving the final score at 36-20.

"One of the keys to the game was our ability to convert third downs," said Pelican Rapids Head Coach **David Haugen**. "On the night we were 10-for-13 on picking up first downs on third down. One of the things that makes that possible was avoiding third and long situations. I was pleased with the way our defense played. Most of the
